FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to register to attend?

Yes, all programs are free events but by pre-registration only. You may register via the corresponding library's website.

Do I need a *Minecraft* account?

No. Even if you/your child owns an account, they will use Minecraft Mania accounts for the duration of the program.

Does my child need a device?

No program *requires* patron technology. If you *have* a tablet or laptop compatible with Minecraft, some libraries may please ask you to supply the device if technology there is limited. You'll be notified during the registration process if the library requests personal devices if possible.

What does it cost?

Nothing! (*Note: our Steve & Kate's Summer Camp programs are exclusive to paid participants of the summer camp.*)

How long are programs?

Traditional programs last 90 minutes; others range from 45 min-2 hours.

May I stay with my child in the program? / Do I need to stay in the library?

If you're expected to stay with younger children in the program room by library policy, you'll be notified during registration. If you *wish* to stay, we can try to accommodate you; however, seating arrangements do not always allow for such configurations. Whether or not you need to stay on library grounds is dependent on library policy; please consult the corresponding library for information regarding this matter.

What do they do for the program?

In addition to having fun in Minecraft, patrons explore their creative imaginations, tackle challenges, make new friends, and even learn how to code!

Who are the hosts/founders?

Minecraft Mania was founded by now-rising-Senior high school students Mitchell Brown and Scotty Vrablik when they were 15. Program staff consist of dedicated high-school students employed & trained by the founders.
